

WCC President Exposed as Communist Agent

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My dear Radio Friend:

Who would have ever thought that it could have come to this—so open, so brazen—but when the World Council of Churches completed its two-weeks' sessions in Uppsala they climaxed it all by electing Patriarch German of Tito's Yugoslavia a president. His record of brutality and murder against the faithful Christians and his faithfulness to the whole Communist regime is beyond dispute. Even the United States Internal Security Subcommittee in 1965 put out a report which exposed him and his activities at length. Now, the ecumenical movement as represented in the World Council of Churches has made him one of their six presidents. The Communist use of religion and infiltration of the churches to the highest level—they can go no higher—has triumphed. And all this has been going on while we have been making efforts through these years to expose it and to stop it.

Please do not let anybody tell you that the Communists have changed or that they are changing. In this world of religion their strategy has gone down the road without deviation to destroy religion by infiltrating it, and destroy the Western world by using the churches to preach the iniquitous doctrine of peaceful coexistence, rapprochement and peace. The World Council of Churches, of course, called the United States the aggressor in Vietnam and said that we had no right to be in there. Even Senator

McGovern, who is now announced as a candidate for the President for the Democratic ticket to carry out the ideals of Robert Kennedy, could not take it. He

called a special press conference and denounced the World Council Assembly for its anti-American stance. Now all of the churches in the United States which are in the National Council of Churches are in the World Council of Churches, and the World Council of Churches and the National Council of Churches are the same people in this country. What is it going to take to speak to the Christians of this country! Have we been so brainwashed, are we so indifferent, or do we just simply not care; are we no longer interested in Christianity being Christianity and standing up for the things that those who believe in God must maintain!

Now all of this activity through these years has conditioned America to the point where we are willing to abandon the concepts of victory in our wars and battles with Communism. Here are some of these reproductions from the Senate document.
