forests in Third World nations. The
demo will take place as the World Bank
begins its annual meeting.

Just prior to this protest -- on
September 28, 29, & 30 -- the Non-
governmental Organization (NGO) will
hold a Citizens' Conference to examine
the destruction of the rainforests by
multilateral development-bank funding
policies.
