"Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the Lord revealed?" (Isa. 53:1.)

"Who hath believed our report?"

Never before in our history have the theories of the higher critics in their attack upon the Bible been brought down to the people in the pews as is being done at this present time. Years ago when I was in seminary we studied these theories, and they were but theories and we cast them aside. Faith Theological Seminary, our own school of the prophets, has been raised up to deal with such attacks and to persuade our young men that they are false, and to equip them to occupy pulpits in our churches from which they will preach the Word of God as it is indeed the Word of the living God.

I have brought to your attention the New Curriculum as it is presented in Canada by the United Church, produced in co-operation with the Baptists of Ontario and Quebec. A million dollars they said they spent on it.

I have been discussing with you the lessons in *Crossroads*, the approach which is being made, beginning in October and running through the entire year, by the United Presbyterians in the U.S.A., presenting the same Graf-Wellhausen hypothesis with all of its ramifications.

I have discussed with you the Methodist publications of this year in which they, too, are presenting the documentary hypothesis of J, E, P, D, and other alleged documents that they say existed at some time, but no one has ever seen them. They reorganize and rearrange and redate the whole Bible.
