The date I have in mind is Wednesday, January 6, 1982. On Friday, January 8, 1982 I'm addressing the Rotary Club Of Syracuse, New York for the third time. The way I travel, Syracuse and Buffalo is the "same area."

There is a good chance that materials are not returned to you after they are passed along thus I'm enclosing a fresh set for the party or parties charged with programs in the January period. The big reprint from the Christian Science Monitor is a good introductory piece in that it is an accurate background account of my life's work. The reprints bearing my byline represent a tiny fraction of pieces published over the years. The copies of letters from Rotary and Kiwanis and the general business community, also a tiny fraction of the whole will indicate how my programs have been received.

My program is called "Liberals, Conservatives, Moderates: And The Far Out." We simply do not use political shorthand well in this country, a pity in my view for when properly applied, political labels become very necessary and useful tools of political analysis.

Because I've severed all ties with aggressive and overpriced lecture managements, I'm now able to offer modest, flexible, and sensible fees to interested groups. I broke with lecture managements because they had priced me out of most markets, i.e., small schools, service clubs, churches, temples, civic organizations, etc. I do hope something might be worked out with Buffalo Kiwanis on Wednesday, January 6, 1982.
