Message from the Patriarch of Moscow

Message of Greeting from His Holiness Alexis, Patriarch of Moscow and all Russia,
to the members of the Central Committee of the WCC at their meeting in St. Andrews,
Scotland.

Greetings to you, dear leaders and participants in the meeting dedicated to the great
cause of Christian unity. May God's blessing be upon your work and your efforts towards
the end that all Christians throughout the world may "be of one heart and of one soul"
(Acts 4. 32).

Praying continually for the "peace of the whole world" and for the uniting of all men
under our Lord Jesus Christ, the Russian Orthodox Church is closely following the develop-
ments in the movement of the divided western and eastern Christians towards church unity.
She looks forward with hope to the day when they will share in the fullness of Faith.

And now, on the occasion of the 50th anniversary of the birth of the ecumenical move-
ment, we give our blessing to our observers attending the present session of the Central
Committee. We charge them fully to acquaint themselves with the substance of its decisions
and with the spirit in which these are taken so that we may be enabled to contribute towards
Christian unity "till we all come in the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son
of God unto a perfect union, unto the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ"
(Eph. 4. 13).

Believing in the One, Holy Catholic and Apostolic Church, founded by our Lord Jesus
Christ and protected by His promises, we know that many Christians, influenced by different
teachings, political differences and national hostilities, and divided from each other by
