 - * Developed new educational materials, including a soon-to-be-completed video that documents and celebrates healing change for homosexuals.

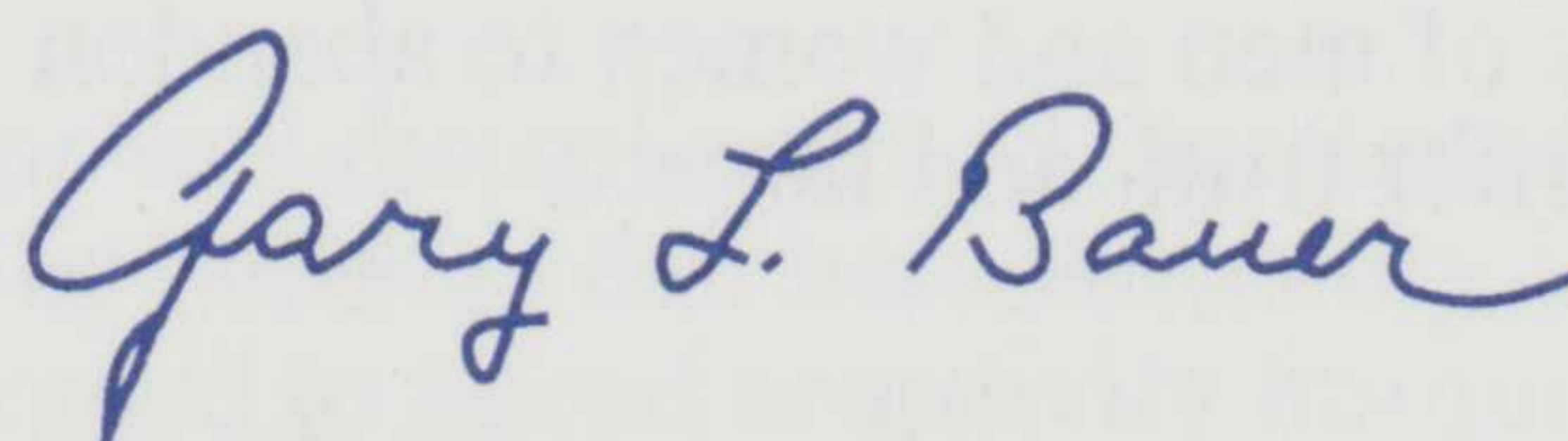

We must stop the federal Employment Non-Discrimination Act (ENDA), a bill that will create incredible invasions of morality and privacy and lead to workplace quotas for abnormal sexuality. We must end funding for the homosexual propaganda spread by the National Endowment for the Arts and through AIDS programs that misspend our tax dollars.

I pray you will choose to help us in the fight. I know these issues are hard to talk about. Our side did not choose these battles, but fight we must. Our children must know that we are doing everything in our power to preserve the blessings of marriage and family for them. The message we must send to homosexual activists is simple: as creatures of God, they are loved, but as gatekeepers of a civil society, we cannot -- and will not -- give in to their destructive demands.
