I apologize for taking so long in answering for note of inquiry of last April. I'm curious, where did you find our name / address?

Anyhow, Borderlands Education Committee ^(B.E.C.) formed in 1979 and for about a year and half we showed a slide presentation we laboriously developed about the border and Mexico, its history and the history of Mexican-Chicano resistance and migration. We published a pamphlet covering all of this. The pamphlet - somewhat outdated on current Mexican state politics - is available for \$1⁰⁰ plus^a mailing charge. It's called "Conflict and Migration".

B.E.C. originally formed from a circle of anti-imperialists with experience in community and student organizing here in San Diego and southern California.

By the early '80's BEC had evolved and we were working within the anti-draft, solidarity and peace movements. In June 1982 we published the first issue of "The whole Damn Pie Shop" as a progressive newsletter and forum.
