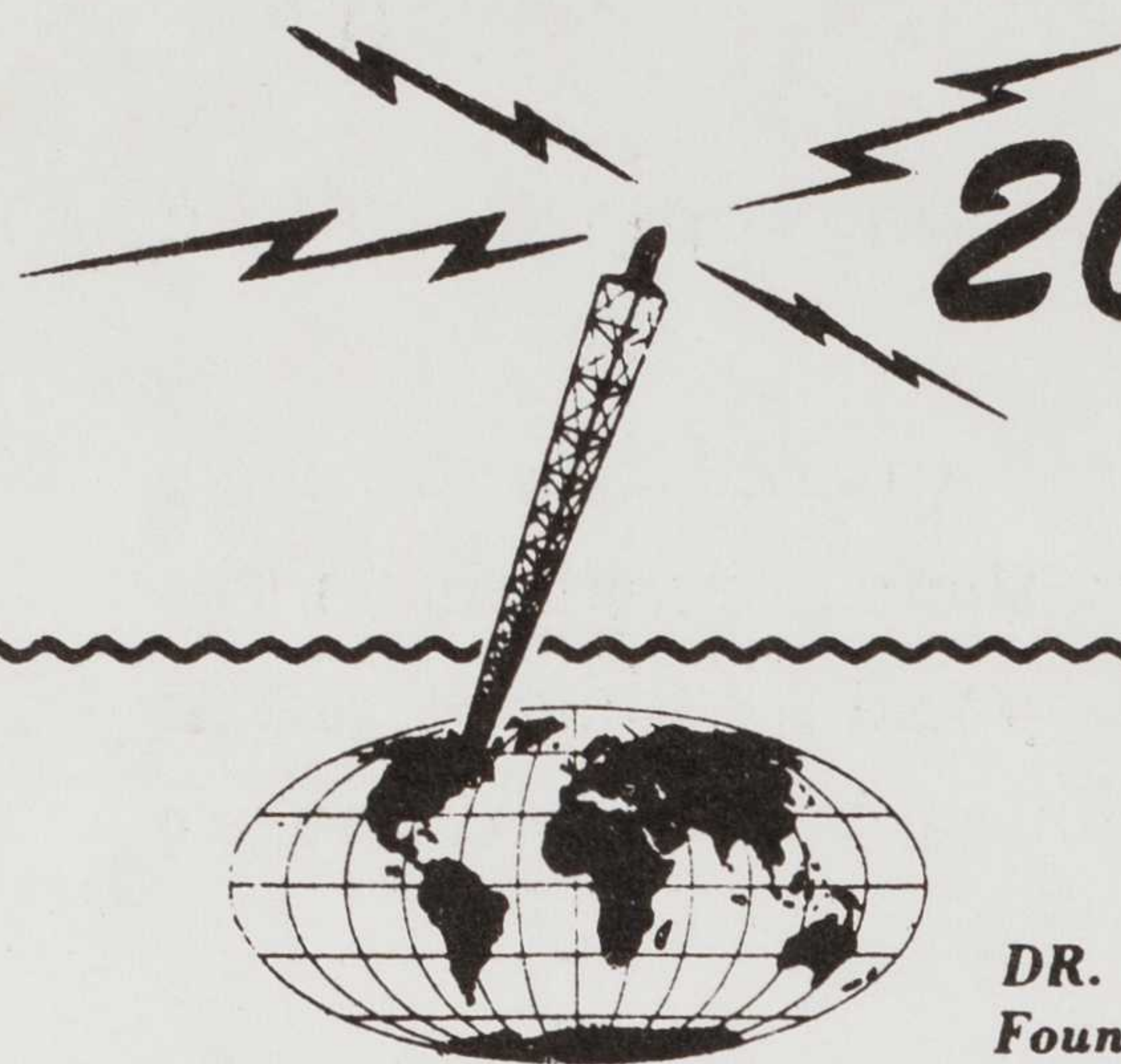

My dear gracious friend:

The next two months are crucial, perhaps as never before for our ministry and even for this country.

Literally we are helping the Communists as we have never done since the Soviet revolution. Gorbachev is being accepted and honored and helped as never before. If you could get the November issue of *Reader's Digest*, there is an article that every American should read on the inside of the KGB, the Soviet secret police. I have used it both on my radio and TV programs.

There is nothing that the Soviets are doing that is not to the end that they will destroy us. We are being deceived, exploited, double crossed, all with smiles and sweet words. The Far East is really being undermined at our expense.

United States support for Red China was built upon the thesis that we would build up an opponent to the Soviets. That was the line that was handed to us. Now the foreign ministers of Red China and the Kremlin have met and a summit is being planned next year for them, and now we are being told that that is a welcomed development and a great accomplishment.

The U.S. has put pressures on South Korea to seek reconciliation with North Korea. Then when there is a move to yield to these pressures, the story is that Washington is pleased that Korea, South Korea is being led to do this. We have an editorial in *The New York Times*, October 21, after the President of South Korea spoke to the UN which says that South Korea "is reaching out to the Communist world." The Communists are playing double with us. The dictator Kim, in North Korea, said he would not have any negotiations until the parliament or the congress of South Korea met with their congressional leaders. The condition is that they are to change their law with their strong anti-Communist position.

On the other hand, the dictator, Kim, in North Korea breathes out his threatenings, which keep the U.S. spending billions and billions as we have since the war ended in 1953, 35 years ago. The Communists want to keep the United States sending these billions as the North makes its threats.

President Reagan said last week that if things were more reconcilable, we could take our troops out. Just think what it has cost us not to win the war when General MacArthur had victory at hand when he was fired. Now comes Vietnam wanting American dollars, wanting us to bail them out. They are using the same strategy that the Soviets used.

U.S. Pressures on Free China have had their effects. Every nation out there is doing business in helping Red China with their slave labor, producing the goods the West is buying and giving them hard currency. The Soviets are no longer an evil empire in the public mind. Both South Korea and Israel of all places are now establishing diplomatic relations with Communist Hungary, a so-called "moderate" Communist state.

It looks like the whole world is now accepting Communism, and if you can't beat them, join them. The anti-Communist posture which we have had is being melted down and is fading away.

The speed with which all of this is taking place has a paralyzing effect as the frightful consequences of it begin to dawn on many and they feel helpless.

All of this makes me want to fight harder, reach more people, strengthen our faith and our resolve to look to God to help us and deliver us.
