Epton, in fact, co-sponsored a similar pro-Queer bill in the state senate.

Among other issues covered in the exchange between Jones and his two Black adversaries, was the June 8, 1967 Israeli attack of the U.S.S. Liberty which killed 34 Americans and wounded 171 others, and Black crime in Chicago.

Jones cited a 1978 Chicago Police Department report that revealed of 823 murders committed in Chicago in 1977, of the 729 killers convicted, 663 were non-White! Kelly said this was a result of "institutional racism" on the part of White society.

The last question dealt with Jones' and Kelly's predictions as to how Chicago would fare under Harold Washington. Kelly predicted Washington would be a "great mayor" and would "unite the city behind him." Jones predicted the opposite. Said Jones: "Harold Washington will go down in history as the greatest political bungler ever to hold that office and the people of Chicago will suffer greatly from it."

It Can Be Done
