is a non-denominational Christian ministry which helps those who are struggling with homosexuality. Started in 1985, we provide counseling and small group support, discipleship training, and encouragement for those who want change in their lives.

Many individuals, and society as a whole, have accepted disinformation which alleges that homosexuality is an inborn condition, unchangeable, and therefore "natural." In the face of this, churches and believers have been facing two increasingly extreme positions: either to accept homosexual relationships as normal and to bless them -- and regard Biblical injunctions as culturally irrelevant or in error-- or to dismiss gay people as immoral, hedonistic, and deserving only of God's wrath.

Transformation believes there is a third approach: the healing of the homosexual condition. Along with a growing movement of ministries which specialize in this area, we believe that homosexuality is a result of emotional and spiritual needs that were not met in childhood. As these essentially normal needs for love and belonging are met, change occurs. An obedient walk with the Lord, mature relationship with men and women, and a healthy self-image are necessary for one's God-given heterosexuality to emerge.

Our Call

- 1) To bring freedom from homosexuality to all who desire it and to disciple them in the Christian faith.
- 2) To be a resource for the Church in our area to help her in ministering to people struggling with homosexuality.
- 3) To bring the love of Christ to the gay community.
- 4) To assist and encourage the formation of more ex-gay ministries in New England.

Our Program

- 1) Small group activities for discipleship, teaching, discussion, sharing and prayer.
- 2) Counseling, in person and by phone.
- 3) Speaking engagements for churches, schools, and other interested parties.
- 4) Counseling, help, and small groups for the loved ones of gay people, especially parents and spouses.
