LITANY OF COMMITMENT

Leader: Let us stand and make or renew our commitment.

Response: What can we do? How can we help?

Therefore, will you resolve to keep Oscar Romero in your heart; and live in solidarity with the poor, persecuted and oppressed here in the United States, throughout the world and especially in Central America?

Leader: Will you remember the 4 martyred U.S. churchwomen and share their loving service of the poor?

Response: We will! We will!

Leader: Will you remember the more than 75,000 dead of El Salvador, martyrs in the martyred land in the last decade? Will you also, like they, pledge to work for peace with social justice in El Salvador and throughout the world?

Response: We will! We will!

Leader: Will you keep in your hearts the six martyred Jesuit priests and their two co-workers and press the U.S. Congress to stop the U.S.-funded violence in El Salvador?

Response: We will! We will!

Leader: Then the light of these martyrs will burn brightly in our world through your lives.
