A CALL TO ACTION

ABORTION RIGHTS ACTION WEEK is a nationally coordinated series of local events scheduled for October 22-29, 1979. It was initiated by over fifty sponsoring organizations who felt that while the right to abortion was under attack, it was important to visibly celebrate and affirm our reproductive rights.

During the summer and early fall of 1979 a campaign will be mounted to gather 50,000 signatures (1,000 from each of the fifty states) on this CALL TO ACTION.

At the end of Abortion Rights Action Week, the Calls will be centrally collected in each state. Then, a fifty-woman delegation will gather in Washington, D.C. to formally present our Call to Action to a selected group of official representatives.
