

We also remember the restraining order which deprived our soldiers from occupying all of Germany and other central European countries which would have freed millions of people from Communist slavery. The gigantic international conspiracy has revealed itself too many times to be classed as accidental or coincidental. The time has come when the loyal patriotic Americans must band together to save themselves and this Nation from falling into the Communist orbit through the sweet scented words of World Government, brotherly love, coexistence and pacification.

The Eisenhower administration wholeheartedly supports, financially and otherwise, in all the varied meanings of these words, every agency of the United Nations, even though they are known to be infiltrated or dominated by Communists, some of whom are in a position to dominate and dictate our own educational policies for our children.

The Eisenhower campaign promised and the thirty-three million Americans demanded an end to the ruinous spending, the coddling of subversives, the constant mind-conditioning for Communist serfdom that flourished under the New and Fair Deals. It promised and we hoped for a return to Americanism, self-respect and courage in the face of aggression, whether from within or without. It promised and we expected a return to traditional American government. But these voters have been cheated, their votes nullified by willful politicians who tore up their platforms shortly after election day.

In seventeen months a political convention will be held to determine the future of our nation. This will be the most momentous period in our history. Upon the American People's shoulders rests an irrevocable choice between a future of liberty or slavery. If the thinking, conservative voters who thought they could redirect the course of government through the election of Dwight Eisenhower will awaken to their error and enter en masse whatever nominating machinery is used in their individual localities and work for the nomination of candidates whose first consideration is the national welfare, and individual liberty, real success can be achieved at the subsequent elections.

Party labels have become so meaningless that we should not permit them to interfere with our support of or opposition to any candidate. Of primary importance is the political philosophy of the candidate himself. A few political leaders have already declared themselves; others will do so as the days pass. As voters, we should encourage those who demonstrate patriotism, integrity, courage and initiative should be encouraged; and from among them we should choose the leaders of a campaign to save America from the ruinous bipartisan foreign and domestic policies created by Roosevelt, perpetuated by Truman and advanced by Eisenhower.

The nomination of the two most mentioned presidential candidates in 1956 would be disastrous to the Nation and would reduce the vote in the national election to an unbelievable low due to the lack of difference between their ideas and philosophies. Conservative Democrats, Republicans and independents, lacking a candidate representing their views, will stay away from the polls thus guaranteeing a one party socialistic internationalistic control over both parties and the Nation.

Both prospective candidates stand together in favor of: atomic secret sharing, coexistence, United Nations, UNESCO, central government, federal aid to (and domination of) education, and integration of schools.
