

The Association of the Miraculous Medal

Soon after the first Miraculous Medals were made, the Vincentian priests and brothers in Paris formed an association of the Miraculous Medal. It helped them distribute the medals and promote this devotion. Gradually similar associations appeared throughout the world. At Perryville, Missouri, the Vincentian community of the western United States set up The Association of the Miraculous Medal in 1918. It has two purposes:

1. It promotes devotion to Mary, especially as our Lady of the Miraculous Medal.
2. It supports Vincentian priests and missionaries as they bring the gospel of Jesus Christ to the poor.

The Association spreads devotion to our Lady through distribution of Miraculous Medals and religious literature. It also publishes favors received, and it conducts novenas and other services at the National Shrine in Perryville.
