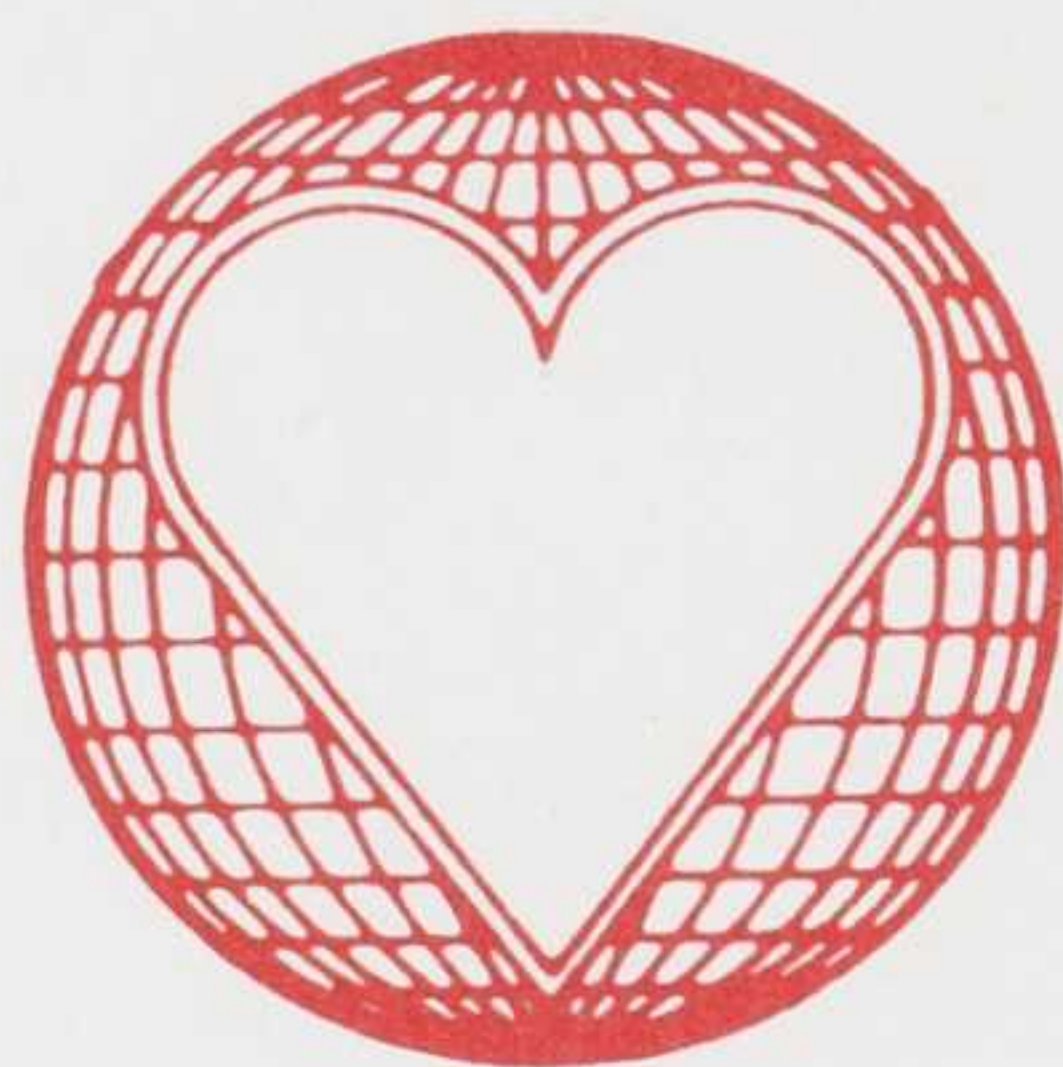




Valentine Vision

The purpose of VALENTINE VISION is to transform Valentine's Day into a time when children and ultimately all people celebrate and express their love for others throughout the world and share their vision of a world without hunger.

VALENTINE VISION is an international friendship program for children. Use this flyer as the basis for conducting the program's key activities:

- Exchanging ideas about how to end world hunger
- Visualization exercises (see script on back)
 - Imaginary Valentine Party
 - Moment of Vision
- Making valentines: As a concrete expression of their love and commitment, participants make valentines for children they don't know. Valentines can then be sent overseas or to local contacts.

VALENTINE VISION has been used by thousands of classroom teachers, scout and religious group leaders, and in national children's celebrations. Key activities can take as little as 25 minutes. The program can also provide a simple, positive basis for a curriculum on global issues and cross-cultural studies with projects and follow-up correspondence continuing throughout the year.
