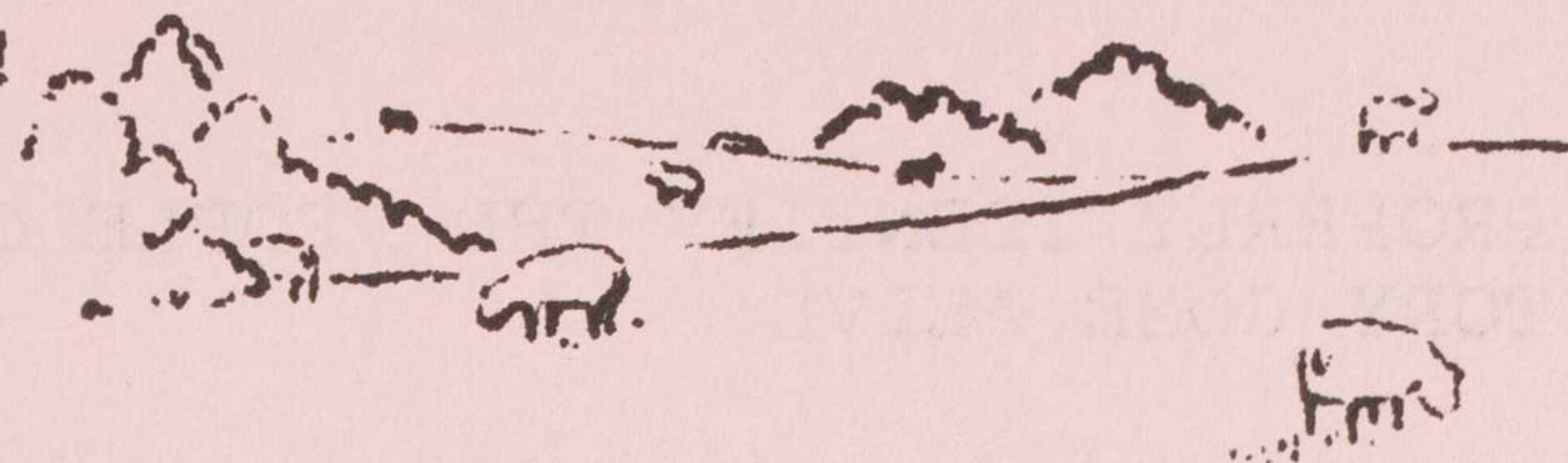
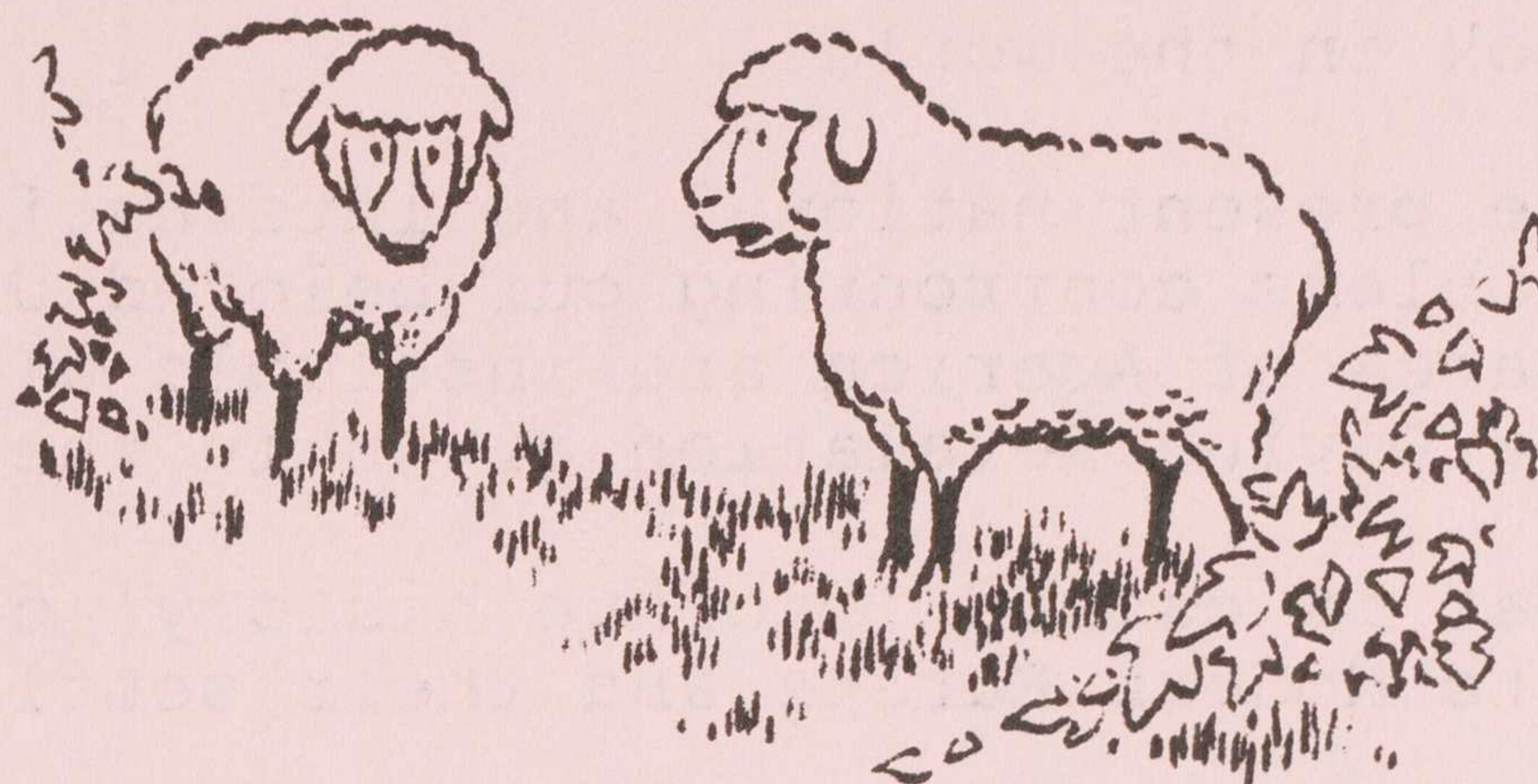


Please tell me=Who went astray? ISRAEL!

"All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; (This includes Dispensationalism) and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all." Isa. 53:5



The PROMISES stated that a multitudinous people would descend from them who would be used by the LORD as A SERVANT PEOPLE to convey God's benevolence (both material & spiritual) to the whole human race...

At Mt. Sinai, God made a BI-LATERAL COVENANT with Israel. (Actually He married Israel!) If they nationally obeyed His Law, they would be blessed. If they did not, they would be punished----Even to the extent of being expelled from their Promised Land.

Bible History amply tells us they DID DISOBEY, and THAT THEY WERE EXPELLED, for punishment and re-training. To await the Prophetic fulfillment concerning the SALVATION-REDEMPTION conferred by the MESSIAH of Israel in His Sacrifice. THE LORD JESUS CHRIST IS THE REDEEMER-KING OF ISRAEL!

Hence Bible history tells of the deportation EN MASSE by the great Assyrian power of the Ten-Tribed Kingdom of Israel to the Caspian Sea region of Media.
