ALDF stands alone in the effort to enforce the amendments to the Animal Welfare Act that mandate exercise for dogs and physical environments to promote the well-being of primates in laboratories.

ALDF halted an Illinois deer hunt by successfully challenging its ecological justification. We're also suing local fish and wildlife departments to block sport hunting of deer, elk, cougars and bears, and defending the First Amendment right of animal activists to confront hunters in the field.

We went to court to block the animal research industry from importing over 70,000 monkeys from Bangladesh. As a result of our intervention, these animals are living today in their natural habitat.

ALDF works to enhance the legal status of companion animals. We've set important legal precedents by establishing the emotional value and true worth of companion animals, as well as ensuring them due process when threatened by government agencies or hostile landlords and neighbors.

We filed suit against the National Marine Fisheries Service to stop the illegal "gray market" in dolphins and other marine mammals. ALDF is fighting to halt "behind closed doors" transfers that take place without public hearings or valid permits.
