Previous correspondence on this project being arranged by Mr. Nilo Ramos in cooperation with PanAm World Airways.

- Nelson de Souza telephonedme this morning. Nilo Ramos was with him. He said they were now considering a *kick-off* luncheon to be held at the National Club around September 9 for between 40 and 50 people. He wondered what leading Americans in the community should be invited.
