THE POWER
OF GOD

"For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God." I Corinthians 1:18.

First of all, let me say, God's power is supernatural. It is not *natural* or, *intellectual* power; and yet, God is intellectual because He knows all, sees all and has all power over all things. God's power is supernatural; and because it is supernatural, natural people sometimes fail to understand its vastness.

Many have said, "If I could see a miracle, I would believe."

And God said, "If you believe you can see a miracle."

Rev. J. C. Hibbard, a friend of mine, pastors the Gospel Lighthouse Church in Dallas, Texas which is one of the largest pentecostal churches in America. He has been on the radio for twenty-five years from 8:30 to 9:00 A.M. seven days a week. One day about fifteen years ago he announced on his radio program that he would visit the people of the city from whom he received the most letters asking him to come. On one single day he received about 3,000 letters from Ft. Worth, Texas requesting him to come to their city.

The next day he announced on the radio that he would go to Ft. Worth. He rented the largest auditorium there, the Will Rogers Memorial Auditorium. When he arrived at about 6:30 P.M. to meet with the platform workers, the song leader, orchestra leader, etc., the auditorium was already packed. Brother Hibbard said, "Brother Culpepper, I stood behind the platform at 6:30 P.M. The place was packed, the police had closed the doors and wouldn't let any more in. I looked down in the audience toward the front and I saw many people on stretchers who were afflicted with every manner of sickness. I saw

blind, crippled and palsied people and it startled me. I went into a little side room and fell down on my knees and began to pray.

"Oh God, there are so many hard cases here tonight. I have never felt so helpless." Just then God spoke to me and said, 'J. C. Hibbard.'

"And I said, 'Yes, Lord.'

"It's not hard for you to preach a sermon?"

"No, because you called me to preach and it's natural."

"J. C. Hibbard, it's not hard for you to eat your breakfast?"

"No, it's not hard. I eat breakfast every morning and enjoy it."

"It's not hard for you to drive your car, take care of your clothes and dress yourself."

"No, it's not hard. It's very natural for me."

"God said, 'Alright, now listen to me carefully. It is just as easy for

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
