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Program and Constitution of the Communist Labor Party

Introduction

The Communist Labor Party is a political party of the working class. It is a revolutionary party with the aim of socialist reconstruction of our society, guided by the advanced theory of scientific socialism: Marxism-Leninism. Our Party is the party of the section of the working class that, for objective economic reasons, is moving into a position of anti-imperialism and anti-capitalism. The Communist Labor Party is the Party of the most oppressed, most exploited section of the class. Only on this basis is it possible to represent the interests of the vast majority of the working class of this country in its spontaneous struggle against capital.

A new type of cyclical crisis is gripping the United States of North America. The bourgeoisie has had options to see them through every previous depression. The depression today is taking place under the conditions of the existence of a world bourgeoisie, a world market and no possibility of expanding the system. The dialectic of history has forced the USNA bourgeoisie into a position where it now must perform its last historic act. It must revolutionize its own gravediggers. The individual capitalist must maintain the highest rate of profit or be devoured by the competition. The USNA proletariat, an indispensable element of a hitherto invincible national political unity, is the most important remaining source for increased exploitation. The capitalist class has attacked the most vulnerable section of the working class with a fury and avarice attainable only by a class whose economic foundations lie in the forced breeding and sale of children.
