

HOUSING

Be sure to have hotel reservations before you get into town. If you have requested alternative housing, we will be in touch with you. We will not be able to provide alternative housing for people who have let us know their need.

TEST SITE

We will be able to accommodate people with medical difficulties at the Test Site but please let us know ahead of time if you need our assistance.

NON VIOLENCE TRAINING

All participants, whether or not you plan to be arrested, must attend our non violent training, even if you have attended others in the past. Several elements of this event require special attention to the training including heat concerns, scenario, non-violent code and legal briefing. We are also interested in taking every opportunity to be together to build community, to join our spirits for one united faithful witness.

LEGAL

For those participating in civil disobedience, we still do not know if there will be immediate arraignment. Much of the risk of this action will be a possible return trip to Las Vegas/Beatty for a court appearance. We will do everything we can to facilitate your return trip arrangements but participants are ultimately responsible for their actions.

One likely outcome of a first time at the Test Site conviction is 24 hours of community service. In the past the judge has agreed to allow those convicted to serve the sentence in their home community. Please come prepared with a possible service site, it's address and the name of the director of the organization.

SPECIAL EVENTS

Along with the daily witness at the Test Site, there will be other events in town during the four days. Please check the schedule for times and locations of evening vigil and guest speakers. We are very pleased to have Fr. Henri Nowen, Dr. Daniel Ellsberg and Rev. Jim Wallis joining us and addressing the local community.
