

TWO EUROPEAN RESISTERS ON HUNGER STRIKE

Two European draft resisters, members of International Collective Resistance, went on hunger strike in February. Thierry Aucher of France went on hunger strike when he was arrested on February 20. Ger Pouw of the Netherlands went on hunger strike on February 22. Both need letters of solidarity and letters of protest against their imprisonment.

In the French case, send your letters of solidarity to Thierry Aucher, Service Neuro-psychiatre, route de Toulouse, Villenove d'Ormon, 33998 Bordeaux-armees, France. Your protest should go to the judge: M. Bourdoncle, 188 rue de Pessac, 33000 Bordeaux, France.

In the Dutch case, send your letter of solidarity to Ger Pouw, "de Sprang", Stevinstraat 405, Scheveninger, The Netherlands. Protests may be directed to The Prime Minister, Het plein 1, Den Haag, Netherlands.
