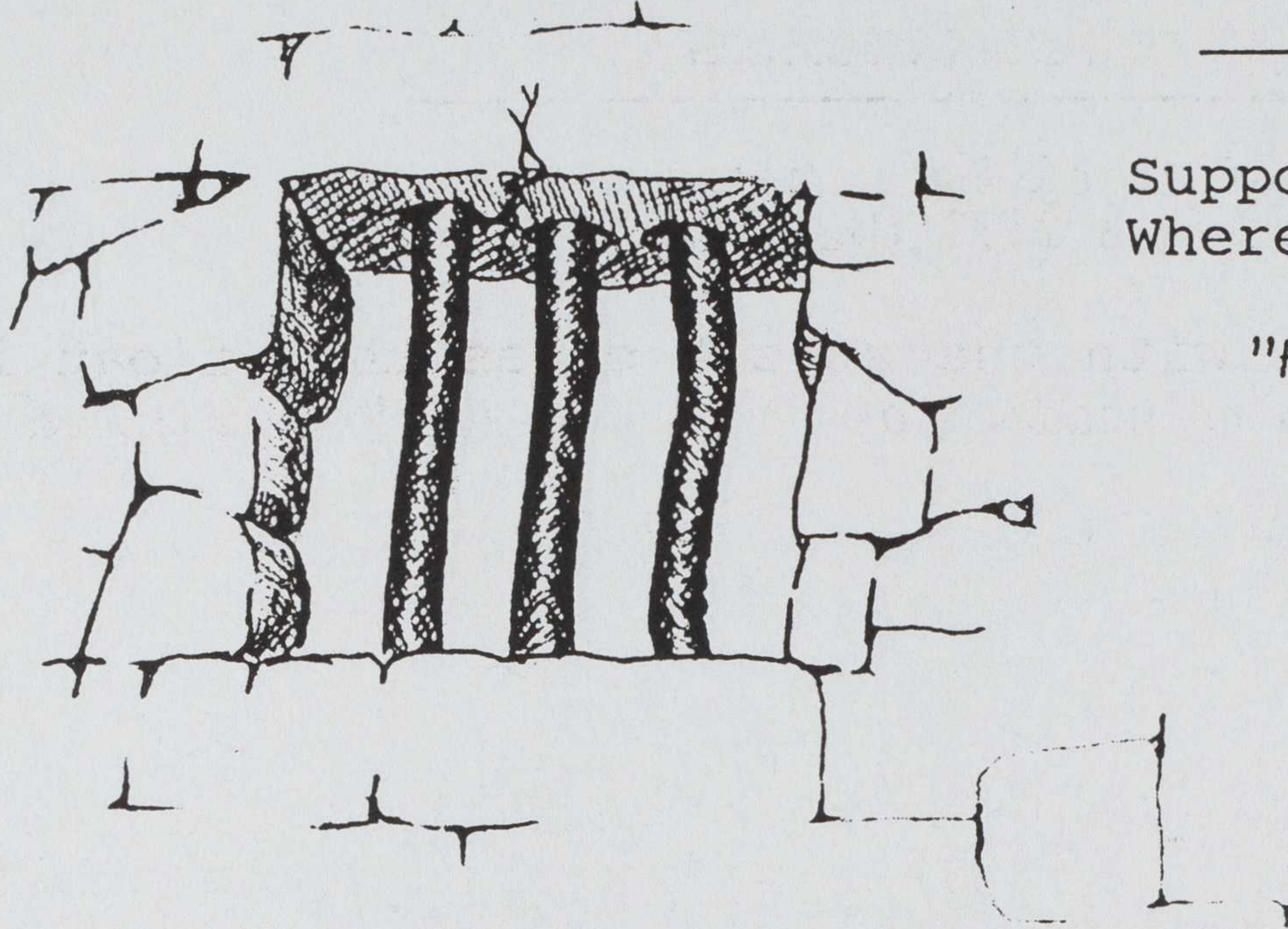


THE EPITOME OF FAILURE...

himself, he cannot save others.

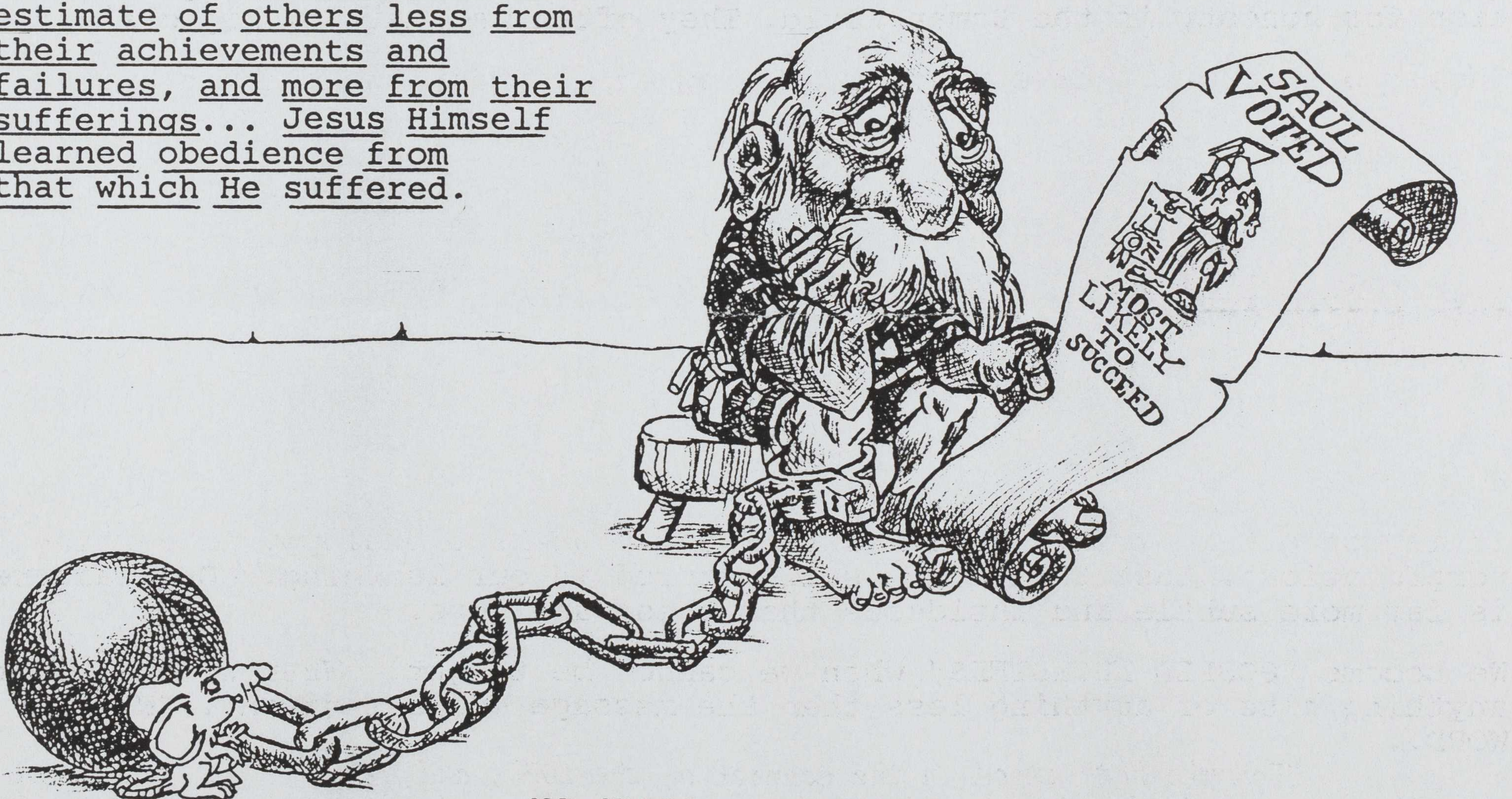
Christian character is the
