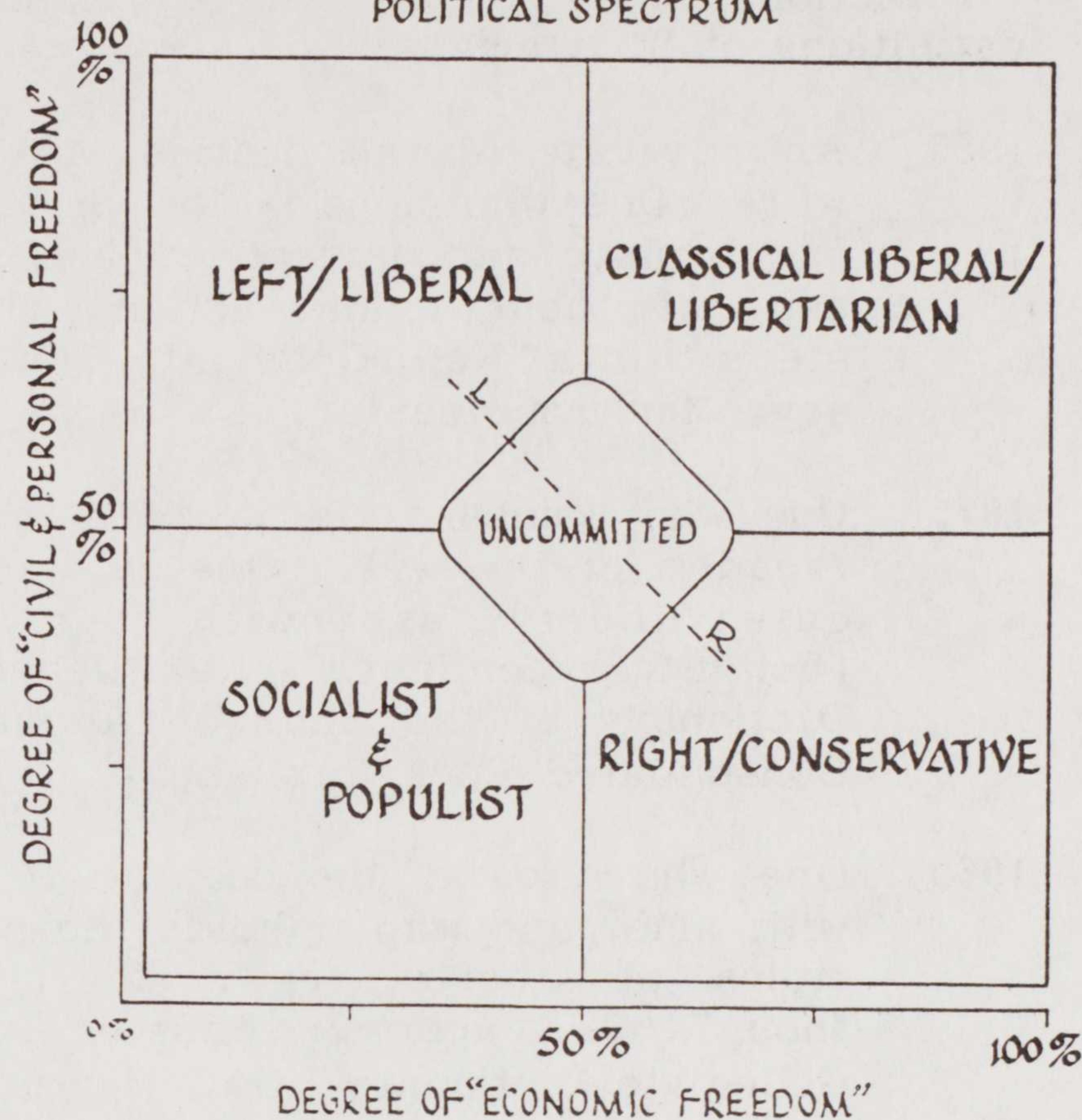
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So far we've thought of three ways the game is valuable to the movement:
