● Slight Hope of Saving America

"I can see slight hope of saving our nation from going socialistic or communistic. There are **LESS THAN A DOZEN MEN** in the United States Senate who consistently vote to maintain **THE AMERICAN FORM OF GOVERNMENT** willed to us by our forefathers. This was the form of government we had until 1932."

Those were the words of Senator W. Lee O'Daniel, Democrat, of Texas, when he announced that he did not choose to run for re-election in 1948.

He also said, "I am thoroughly convinced, after careful study at close range, that the main objective of the vast majority of the elected federal officials is to get themselves re-elected, re-elected and re-elected, and that **THE TERRIBLE CONDITION** existing in our federal government today is due primarily to the fact that the vast majority of these officials do the things that will help to get themselves re-elected, instead of doing the things that are best for the welfare of our nation."

Mr. O'Daniel said that "a thorough housecleaning" was needed in Washington. He did not think he could contribute anything by returning to Washington for six more years "and voting with a hopeless minority."
