The case in mention was a reletively minor ursurpation of power, compared to some we are trying to waken the public to. Enclosed is the latest edition of our publication. We earnestly hope you will seek out the sources of information contained in the centerfold.

We are planning to extend our activities through film showings, Lectures, study groups, etc. and to greatly magnify our letter writing campaigns.
