

us to God. It is not a theory that He gave Himself as a propitiation. And that is the word they do not like to use, this word in which the Son of God became a single, holy, sinless, righteous sacrifice in the sight of an Almighty God, and by the offering up of Himself He met every demand of infinite, perfect justice against our disobedience. That is not a theory! That is the Book of Romans. It is the Book of Galatians.

You never, in the 31 years that I have preached to you, heard me stand in this pulpit and speak about a *theory* of an atonement. I have preached to you people the blood of Jesus Christ as alone having the power to cleanse you from your sins and give you justification in the sight of a Holy God. We do not deal in theories. We do not talk about theories in our Sunday school publications. We teach our young people the truth. And we do not judge our salvation on the basis of experience. We judge our salvation on the basis of the Word of God.

Now there it is, beloved. It is a massive attack! We have never had anything like it in all history. When they get through tearing the Bible to pieces, when they get through pulling it down, when they get through with all the millions of dollars they are spending to develop this new approach to the Scriptures, what kind of Jesus will they have left? One whom their experience creates. One whom they desire to lead them down the road to the great kingdom of God which they have created in their own thinking. I see these things and they just break my heart. To think that we would come upon such a day! Here we are — a little band. We see these things. I can explain them to you. But we will go by the Scriptures, and we will judge everything by this precious Word. All we can do is ask God to keep us faithful and pray that our little ones may not be led astray and deceived. All that we can do is to ask God to give us strength to be steadfast, to be unmoveable, and to abound in the work of the Lord.

“Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the Lord revealed?” We believe in Christ. And here is the mighty arm of God as He spoke through Isaiah and Daniel, and He tells us that the Son of God is coming in the clouds of heaven and when He comes He will indeed be the Ancient of Days. My friends, believe the Word of God. Do not judge your salvation by your experience. Do not take an incident out of your corrupted experience and say, This is my creed. Take your creed and your faith from the infallible revelation that we have had and that the church has preached and believed in for 2,000 years.
