Facts about the Bible

The Bible was the first book printed (about 1450) and the Authorized or King James Version is today for English-speaking people the Bible—the most widely circulated book in the world.

The Bible contains 3,566,480 letters, 773,693 words, 31,102 verses, 1,189 chapters and 66 books."

The word "and" occurs 46,277 times and the word "reverend" but once.

The 19th chapter of 2 Kings and the 37th chapter of Isaiah are nearly alike.

The middle verse of the Bible is Psalm 118:8.

The twenty-first verse of the seventh chapter of Ezra contains all letters of the alphabet, except J.

The word Lord occurs 1,855 times. The longest word is in 8th chapter of Isaiah, first verse.

In the New Testament there are about 180 direct quotations from the Old Testament.

The King James or Authorized Version of the Bible was first printed in 1611.

The first Bible printed in this country was in the Indian language in 1663.

The first English Bible printed in this country was in 1782.
