Order and domestic tranquility to a nation sorely beset by disorder.

A return to respect for the law and an opportunity for every citizen to pursue his lawful daily activities in safety and security.

To restore dignity, strength and prestige of this nation to a level commensurate with its position as acknowledged leader of the nations of the free world.

To offer opportunity for an early honorable peace to a nation at war.

And, above all, we offer to each individual citizen a system of government recognizing his inherent dignity and importance as an individual and affording him an opportunity to take a direct hand in the shaping of his own destiny and the destiny of this nation.

Under such a system, we are convinced, America will reach new heights of greatness.

The Principles of the American Party

In order to establish the American Party of the U.S.A., to set forth the documents stating our principles to which all people of good character and moral decency may subscribe, to affirm our reliance and faith in the divine creator, to work together in harmony, to put into effect the concepts of our founding fathers those ideas which will achieve these benefits, we do set forth this statement of principles.

The American Party affirms that the purpose of the existence of this political party is to preserve, protect and defend the Constitution of the United States of America against all enemies, domestic and foreign.

The American Party of the U.S.A. shall address itself to:

- (1) Restoring a sense of and a devotion to decency among all men.
- (2) Encouraging the individual to become more responsible to God, Family, Self, Country and State.
- (3) Restoring the Sovereignty of the states as de-

fined by the Constitution of these United States.

(4) Restoring the Sovereignty of the people of the states.

(5) Instituting a sense of loyalty to the ideas of liberty within the Constitution of these United States.

(6) A recognition that rights cannot be transferred among people nor transgressed by the state.

We believe that efficiency and prudence in governmental spending will lead to a healthy and stable economy, free from need for ever increasing taxation. As a matter of fact, elimination of those governmental operations in competition with private enterprise will lead to a reduction of and the eventual elimination of personal income tax.

We favor the return of schools to the local school authorities in accordance with constitutional principles, including local control of textbooks and curriculum.

We favor the return of voluntary prayer and Bible reading in our public schools.

We affirm that there can be no civil rights without property rights.

We oppose any guaranteed annual income at the expense of taxpayers.

Equal rights belong to a law-abiding citizen.

We propose a review of the judicial system with a view toward imprisonment and removal from society of repeat violators.

Civil disorders and revolution for any reason cannot be condoned.

We oppose a federal or national police force in any form and therefore favor efforts to support our local police, to keep them independent, and free of federal subsidy.

We uphold the right of law-abiding citizens to keep and bear arms without restriction in accord with the original meaning of the Second Amendment of the Constitution.

We advocate a thorough investigation of the conspiratorial causes of campus disorders, civil riots and revolution.

We favor a free and open market as a means of price stabilization rather than to continue inflation through Government control.

We uphold the rights of the local, state, or federal employees to be free of compulsory, political contributions.

We oppose any change in the Electoral College

We urge the restoration of the freedom of the press by breaking up monopolies in the newspapers, radio, and television.

We oppose forced housing.

We believe in the constitutional right to own,

rent, and dispose of privately owned property with no infringement by the local, state or federal government or any appointive authority.

We oppose any interference by government in the operation of private clubs, and other private institutions.

We urge the physical and financial reduction of all levels of government.

We have cause to believe that the greatest threat to the sovereignty of the U.S.A. exists in the form of the International Communist Conspiracy and as such it must be defeated by all freedom-loving Americans. We also oppose any of the other forms of tyranny including Collectivism, Socialism, Fascism, Nazism. We therefore recommend appropriate steps to render these powers ineffective.

We establish as a cardinal principle opposition to any elected or appointed official who supports and/or votes for aid to Communist countries.

We are opposed to unilateral disarmament and any related projects such as disarmament treaties and common projects with the Soviet Union.

We advise that the U.S.A. break off all diplomatic, cultural or trade relations with any and all Communist governments.

We urge that the U.S.A. resign from the United Nations and remove our support, moral, physical, or financial, from any of the related institutions such as the World Bank, the World Court, and the World Health Organizations.

Whereas, in war there is no substitute for victory; therefore the American Party adopts as a primary tenet of policy that whenever the United States becomes involved in any war, we shall use the full force of our military, economic, and financial power to achieve victory as quickly as possible over the enemy.

Upon these principles and with firm reliance on Divine Providence, the American Party offers the voters a clear and definite choice.
