

That means that demons departed when the cloth was placed upon the body.

Countless thousands are being healed today by the ministry of blessed cloths. God has made this provision for the sake of the many that cannot get to us for help, that although we cannot reach them and lay hands upon them personally, we can send them a cloth that our hands have touched. This is God's scriptural method of contacting those that are sick and bound and afflicted, and cannot get into direct contact with those whose faith is strong, and whom the Lord is using in this ministry. As the ministry of blessed cloths brought deliverance to thousands in Paul's day, it is still bringing miraculous deliverance now. Thousands of miracles are taking place today through this simple ministry. This method of sending forth cloths from the bodies of God's anointed ministers is still effective.

God has no respect of persons. Those who are sick should receive these cloths in faith. They should follow the same instructions as those standing in the healing line. When this cloth is laid upon the body of the afflicted person, that person should exercise the same faith that he would if he were in the healing line, and hands actually were laid upon his body. If he will do this, the same results will follow, in every case.

These cloths that are received in faith, bear the same virtue and power that the hands of the evangelist bear. This is the scriptural provision that God has made for the countless thousands that cannot attend the divine healing services that are being conducted over the country today.

In a campaign last summer, a woman came to me with a heavy burden on her heart for her husband

who was a confirmed drunkard. In her hand she had a little square of cloth. She believed that if her husband came in contact with this cloth over which I had prayed, he would be delivered from the demon of drink. I prayed over the cloth. She told me she was going to take it home and place it in her husband's pillow, believing the evil spirit would have to depart if her husband got close to the pillow.

Four nights later the woman was back in the campaign telling what great things God had done through the cloth. Within three days after she had placed the cloth in her husband's pillow, **HE WAS GLORIOUSLY SAVED, AND DELIVERED FROM THE DEMON OF DRINK!**

In Rock Island, Illinois, I prayed over another cloth for a woman, who placed this cloth in the toe of her husband's shoe. This woman declared her husband was demon possessed, and one of the meanest men in town. The man wore the shoe only twenty hours before he got saved!

Another woman took one of these little cloths from our tent services. Her husband was bound by an evil spirit, and the man had said he would never get saved. This woman was not as clever in concealing the cloth as many others were, but pinned it plainly to the waistband of a pair of shorts she had brought him to put on. Upon seeing the little bit of cloth pinned to his fresh shorts, he demanded to know what it was. She was very sweet about the whole thing, but would not tell him what the little cloth was. He insisted that he must know what it was for, or he would not wear the shorts. She requested in a sweet manner that he please put the shorts on and wear them without any more questions.
