"Paradise and Old Noah Khrushchev," the latest blasphemy of Nikita Khrushchev, is reported by C. L. Sulzberger, foreign correspondent for the New York Times, from Moscow, Sept. 8. Sulzberger talked at length to Mr. K. He "brought down the house--interpreter, aides and secretary," with his exposition of the emptiness and futility of "heaven."

He declared that the Soviet people are not interested in heaven or anything that relates to the subject. But one of the purposes of sending the astronauts out into outer space was to examine this question of heaven. "'First,'" Khrushchev said, "'we sent up our explorer, Yuri Gagarin. He circled the globe and found nothing in outer space. It's pitch dark there, he said; no Garden of Eden, nothing like heaven. So we decided to send another. We sent Gherman Titov and told him to fly for a whole day. After all, Gagarin was up there only an hour and a half. So he might have missed paradise.' [Here the official Russian transcript notes 'merry animation.'] 'We told him to take a good look. Well, he took off, came back and confirmed Gagarin's conclusion. He reported there was nothing there. All this,' continued Mr. Khrushchev, 'does not mean that our people will not fight because they believe there is no afterlife.'"

Then the old tyrant drove hard with his propaganda against the "imperialists, monopolists, colonialists, who also say that they believe in God...."

Yes, we believe in God. He is the Author of Liberty!

Now the United Nations is before us--the struggle to get Red China into the U.N., the terrible debauche in the Congo, the cringing neutralist bloc, and Khrushchev more brazen, boastful and brutal than ever before!

When Khrushchev talks like this and ridicules heaven and despises our hope, mocks the living God, I want to respond by testifying to our blessed Saviour, His grace, His power, His glory!
